Our Mission:

Big Brothers Big Sisters of Colorado helps children reach their *full potential* through professionally supported, one-to-one, volunteer mentoring relationships with measurable impact.

REACH Mentoring Program:

Our REACH Mentoring program serves children who have a parent/guardian serving a State or Federal prison sentence. Children receive a volunteer mentor - a "Big Brother" or a "Big Sister". Children are eligible for either a traditional Community Mentoring style program and our Sports Buddies programs. Children with Big Brothers and Big Sisters mentors are proven more likely to get along with their peers, perform better in school, are less violent, and have stronger positive self-esteem.

Children Eligible for REACH Mentoring:

We serve children in the Denver Metro area (Denver/Aurora/Boulder) who:

- Are between the ages of 7 and 12.
- Have a parent/guardian who is currently serving a State or Federal prison sentence.
- *Children in homes without an adult (18+) fluent in English may be placed on a waitlist as we search for bilingual mentors.*
