Indoor Activities

- Most public libraries in the Denver Metro Area offer FREE admission to local museums and state parks through a cultural/museum/exploration pass. - Grab some coloring supplies, a book, homework assignment or work on a bucket list for future match activities with your Little and hang out at one of the local food halls equipped for social distancing. - Visit a museum together - check out a list of museums in the Denver area [here](#) and remember kids 18 and under get into the Denver Art Museum for FREE!

- Try out some new food at a restaurant together or get it to go and eat at a park
- Grab a hot drink at a local coffee shop
- Go window shopping at an outdoor mall or check out a local consignment or thrift store
- Create an art project (painting, crocheting, drawing, coloring, etc.)
- Play a board game, put together a puzzle or play card games
- Check out a trampoline park or go bowling
- Create a resume together and practice interviewing skills
- Work on a vision board
- Learn a new skill (i.e. how to bake, cook, draw, garden, take a class together)
- Find a cause you are passionate about and learn how to support it
- Read an article together and challenge each other to think critically about the information provided

Outdoor Activities

- Try [Geocaching](#) – it's a real-world, outdoor treasure hunting game using GPS-enabled devices. Participants navigate to a specific set of GPS coordinates and then attempt to find the geocache (container) hidden at that location. Mount Falcon Park is great for this activity!
